THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTIONS 85-94 WHICH ENDORSES KACHEMAK BAY STATE PARK LAND EXCHANGES WITH SELDOVIA NATIVE ASSOCIATION AND RESOLUTION 88-5 WHICH RELATES TO THE ADDITION OF LAND TO KBSP THROUGH HOUSE BILL 244.

WHEREAS, the KBCC represents a broad based and diverse cross section of the community of Homer and the Kachemak Bay user group and has succeeded in bringing the State of Alaska and SNA together again in a negotiating process after previous failed attempts to do so, and

WHEREAS, KBCC has earned a position of respect from and been encouraged by the 2 parties to participate fully in the negotiations, and

WHEREAS, the goal of the KBCC is the full restoration of Park Lands and therefore to the long term futures of Homer and the Park;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council fully endorses Kachemak Bay State Park land exchanges with Seldovia Native Association and the addition of land to KBSP through House Bill 244.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager shall forward copies of these 3 resolutions to the governor, Commissioner of Natural Resources, Seldovia Native Association and all State Legislators respectfully urging their support of these Council resolutions.
