A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER SCHEDULING THE PUBLIC HEARING DATE FOR THE STERLING HIGHWAY/WEST HILL ROAD WATER/SEVER SERVICE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT TO APRIL 11, 1988.

WHEREAS, on the 8th day of December, 1986 the Homer City Council found there was a need to create a water and sewer service district along the Sterling Highway/West Hill Road area and that it was in the interest of good health and general welfare of the public to have a water and sewer system, and

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council passed Resolution 86-85 creating the Sterling Highway/West Hill Road water/sewer service improvement area and set a date for public hearing of March 9, 1987, and

WHEREAS, that public hearing was re-scheduled to April 13, 1987 via Resolution 87-11; and

WHEREAS, it was necessary for Administration to cancel the public hearing to obtain further information in regards to financing of the project and the most advantageous route and boundaries of the proposed project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer that a new public hearing date is hereby set for the 11th of April, 1988 during the regular City Council meeting beginning at 7:30 p.m. for the purpose of hearing objections or comments to the formation of said improvement district.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Administration will continue to compile the necessary information on the costs of the improvement, notify the property owners of such costs and the scheduled public hearing and to have notice of the hearing published as required by law.
