RESOLUTION 88-13(a)

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING A
HOMEPORTING TASK FORCE, ADVISORY TO THE CITY COUNCIL,
AND PROVIDING FOR THE CONDITIONS AND DURATION OF THAT
TASK FORCE.

WHEREAS, Homer is one of the locations in Alaska being
considered as a possible site for a Navy homeport and;

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council supports the concept of
investigating homeporting in Homer, and;

WHEREAS, the City Council finds the need for information
pertaining to such a facility so that both the Council and the
public are informed as to the impacts of homeporting;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the
City of Homer, Alaska, that there is hereby established a
Homeporting Task Force, advisory to the City Council, subject to
the following conditions:

Section 1. There shall be nine (9) members of the Task
Force, determined by the Mayor, who represent the community at
large. Necessary city staff shall only be advisory to the task
force.

Section 2. The duration of the Task Force shall be for a
period of six (6) months, ending on August 31, 1988.

Section 3. The Task Force shall be responsible for
collecting available information pertinent to the homeport. The
Task Force shall identify information it deems necessary but
which is not readily available.

Section 4. The Task Force is expected to present an interim
report to the City Council in May of 1988. The report should
identify what, if any, additional information they require and a
cost estimate, if necessary, to obtain the information and
proposed methods of obtaining that information.

Section 5. The Task Force is expected to present to the City Council, prior to the expiration of the Task Force, findings of information and recommendations regarding homeporting in Homer for the Council's further review and/or action.
