RESOLUTION 88-14

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING  
SENATE BILL 372 RELATING TO THE APPLICABILITY OF  
THE PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT RELATIONS ACT TO  
MUNICIPALITIES AND POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS.

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 372 clarifies the conditions under  
which a municipality or political subdivision may opt in or out  
of the Public Employment Relations Act; and

WHEREAS, passage of this bill will provide the opportunity  
for all local governments in Alaska to retain local control of  
their bargaining process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of  
the City of Homer supports Senate Bill 372 relating to the  
applicability of the Public Employment Relations Act to  
municipalities and political subdivisions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is authorized  
to send copies of this resolution of support to Governor Steve  
Cowper, Representative Mike Navarre, Representative C. E.  
Swackhammer, Senator Paul Fischer, Senator Ken Fanning as well as  
Scott Burgess and respectfully urge support of the bill.
