AWARDING THE INFLUENT PUMP STATION DIVIDER
WALL PROJECT TO NEAL & COMPANY.

WHEREAS, an invitation to bid was duly advertised by
the City of Homer in the Homer News on February 18th & February
25, 1988; and

WHEREAS, a public bid opening was held at Homer City
Hall on March 3, 1988 at 3:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the apparent responsible low bidder was the
firm of Neal & Company whose total bid price was \$6633;

WHEREAS, the engineer's estimate was \$6950;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City
Council that the influent pump station divider wall project is
hereby awarded to the firm of Neal & Company for the total price
of six thousand six hundred and thirty-three dollars (\$6633.);


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby
