RESOLUTION 88-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL 423 MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR TOURISM AND RECREATION RELATED CAPITAL PROJECTS, GRANTS AND EXPENSES OF STATE GOVERNMENT.

WHEREAS, Committee Substitute for House Bill 423 by the Resource Committee makes appropriations for tourism and recreation related capital projects, grants and expenses of state government; and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer recognizes that a visitor center will enhance economic development opportunities as well as provide a gateway facility for Kachemak Bay State Park; and

WHEREAS, Section 40 provides the sum of \$178,000 from the General Fund to the Department of Administration for payment as a grant under AS 37.05.315 to the City of Homer for design and construction of the Homer Bypass Park/Recreational Vehicle Dump Station.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of Homer supports CS for House Bill 423 making appropriations for tourism and recreation related capital projects, grants and expenses of state government.


