## RESOLUTION 88-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING SENATE BILL 366 RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF REBATES FOR MOTOR FUEL TAXES FOR FUEL USE IN WATERCRAFT OUTSIDE THE STATE AND LIMITING THE AUTHORITY OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL AND THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE TO RECOVER REFUNDS PAID BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT.

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 366 establishes rebates for motor fuel taxes for fuels used in watercraft outside the state limiting the authority of the Attorney General and the Department of Revenue to recover refunds paid before the effective date of this act; and

WHEREAS, Oceantrawl, a catcher-processor of surimi has requested the City of Homer to support Senate Bill 366 in that it would be advantageous for their operation in Alaska.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of Homer supports Senate Bill 366 relating to the establishment of rebates for motor fuel taxes for fuel used in watercraft outside the state and limiting the authority of the Attorney General and Department of Revenue to recover refunds paid before the effective date of the act.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is authorized to send copies of this resolution of support to Governor Steve Cowper, Representative Mike Navarre, Representative C. E. Swackhammer, Senator Paul Fischer, Senator Fred Zharoff as well as members of the Senate Resources Committee, Senate Finance Committee and Scott Burgess of AML respectfully urging support of the bill.
