A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL
FINDING THE NEED TO CREATE THE FAIRVIEW
AVENUE (HOHE TO MULLIKIN) PAVING IMPROVEMENT
DISTRICT AND SETTING A DATE FOR PUBLIC
HEARING.

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council has adopted the Homer Accelerated Road Reconstruction Program, and

WHEREAS, a majority of the voters of the City of Homer approved Proposition #2 for an increased sales tax rate for street reconstruction and related utilities; and

WHEREAS, Fairview Avenue (Hohe to Mullikin) falls within the guidelines of the Homer Accelerated Road Program;

WHEREAS, a petition for the paving of Fairview Avenue (Hohe to Mullikin) was submitted with 56% of the value of property to be benefited property owners signatures;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council that it is the intent of the city to form such an improvement district and that a public hearing will be held during the regular City Council meeting of Monday, May 9, 1988 at 7:30 p.m. for the purpose of hearing protests against the formation of said improvement district;


