A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL FINDING THE NEED TO CREATE THE BONANZA WEST (GLACIER VIEW SUBDIVISION) ROAD RECONSTRUCTION LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AND SETTING A DATE FOR PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council has adopted the Homer Accelerated Roads Reconstruction Program, and

WHEREAS, a majority of the voters of the City of Homer approved Proposition #2 for an increased sales tax rate for street reconstruction and related utilities; and

WHEREAS, Bonanza Avenue west (Glacier View Subdivision) falls with the guidelines of the Homer Accelerated Roads Program as a Group IV, non-maintained road; and

WHEREAS, a petition for road reconstruction of Bonanza west was submitted with 51% of the value of property to be benefited property owner's signatures;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council that it is the intent of the City to form such an improvement district and that a public hearing will be held during the regular City Council meeting of Monday, May 23, 1988 at 7:30 p.m. for the purpose of hearing protests against the formation of said improvement district;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is authorized to compile the necessary information, boundaries and begin to prepare plans for the improvement in order to notify the property owners of such costs and the date of the hearing publicized as required by law.
