A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING CS FOR SENATE BILL 476 CREATING THE SUPPLEMENTAL MUNICIPAL ASSISTANCE FUND FOR RAILBELT COMMUNITIES.

WHEREAS, CS for Senate Bill 476 establishes a supplemental municipal assistance fund for Railbelt communities and authorizes payment to Railbelt communities; and

WHEREAS, Railbelt community has been defined in the Community Substitute to include a community located within a borough that is located within twenty-five miles of the right-of-way of the railroad; and

WHEREAS, the negative Alaska economic situation has dramatically affected the ability of local governments to provide basic public services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council urges the Alaska legislature to support CS for Senate Bill 476 creating the supplemental municipal assistance fund for Railbelt communities.
