RESOLUTION 88-38

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL  
SUPPORTING CS FOR SENATE BILL 476 CREATING  
THE SUPPLEMENTAL MUNICIPAL ASSISTANCE FUND  
FOR RAILBELT COMMUNITIES.

WHEREAS, CS for Senate Bill 476 establishes a  
supplemental municipal assistance fund for Railbelt communities  
and authorizes payment to Railbelt communities; and

WHEREAS, Railbelt community has been defined in the  
Community Substitute to include a community located within a  
borough that is located within twenty-five miles of the right-of-  
way of the railroad; and

WHEREAS, the negative Alaska economic situation has  
dramatically affected the ability of local governments to provide  
basic public services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City  
Council urges the Alaska legislature to support CS for Senate  
Bill 476 creating the supplemental municipal assistance fund for  
Railbelt communities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is  
authorized to send copies of this resolution to Governor Steve  
Cowper, Senator Fischer, Senator Halford, Senator Faiks, Senator  
Josephson, Senator Coghill, Senator Kelly, Senator Fahrenkamp,  
Senator Kerttula, Senator Szymanski, Members of the Senate  
Community and Regional Affairs Committee, Representative  
C. E. Swackhammer, Representative Mike Navarre as well as Scott  
Burgess of AML respectfully urging their support of this  
legislation.
