RESOLUTION 88-39

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING SENATE BILL 477 MAKING A SPECIAL APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AND REGIONAL AFFAIRS FOR SUPPLEMENTAL MUNICIPAL ASSISTANCE TO RAILBELT COMMUNITIES.

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 477 appropriates \$31,752,215 for payment as supplemental municipal assistance to Railbelt communities; and

WHEREAS, this amount reflects the interest which has been earned on the principal of the Railbelt energy fund through December 31, 1987; and


WHEREAS, the pro rata share for the City of Homer would be \$298,270.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Homer City Council urges the Alaska Legislature to support Senate Bill 477 making a special appropriation to the Department of Community and Regional Affairs for supplemental municipal assistant to Railbelt communities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is authorized to send copies of this resolution to Governor Steve Cowper, Senator Fischer, Senator Halford, Senator Faiks, Senator Josephson, Senator Coghill, Senator Kelly, Senator Fahrenkamp, Senator Kerttula, Senator Szymanski, Members of the Senate Community and Regional Affairs Committee, Representative C. E. Swackhammer, Representative Mike Navarre as well as Scott Burgess of AML respectfully urging their support of this legislation.
