A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL AWARDING THE BONANZA AVENUE WEST PROFESSIONAL ENGINEER ROAD DESIGNS BID IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$5,560 TO CORWIN & ASSOCIATES, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Homer did duly and properly advertise for professional engineers for road design services in conjunction with the City of Homer Accelerated Roads Program (ACRP), 660 LF Bonanza Avenue West; and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer held a public bid opening on May 19, 1988 at 2:00 p.m., at Homer City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsible bidder was Corwin & Associates;


