A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL  
AWARDING THE ENGINEERING SERVICES BID FOR THE  
DESIGN OF A DEEP WATER DOCK TO THE FIRM OF  
TRYCK, NYMAN & HAYES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO  
EXCEED \$218,500 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY  
MANAGER TO SIGN THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Homer solicited request for proposals  
for the selection of a design firm to develop plans,  
specifications and technical assistance for the design of the  
Homer Deep Water Dock; and

WHEREAS, only pre-qualified design firms were requested to  
make proposals as authorized by the Homer City Council on the  
13th of June, 1988 via adoption of amended Memorandum 88-83; and

WHEREAS, presentations by pre-qualified firms were made  
before an Evaluation Panel on the 22nd of June, 1988 at Homer  
City Hall;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council  
that the engineering services bid for the design of the Homer  
Deep Water Dock be awarded to the firm of Tryck, Nyman & Hayes,  
in an amount not to exceed \$218,500; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is authorized
