RESOLUTION 88-62

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL
REDESIGNATING LIBRARY LAND ACQUISITION FUNDS
TO PARTIALLY FUND THE LIBRARY DESIGN PROJECT
AND TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER
INTO A LIBRARY DESIGN CONTRACT WITH
ARCHITECTS ALASKA.

WHEREAS, the City of Homer solicited statements of
qualifications and proposals from professional firms to provide
design services for the proposed library expansion; and

WHEREAS, the firm of Architects Alaska was selected as the
best suited to perform the desired services; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the design services plus
other ancillary costs is estimated to be in excess of \$102,000;
and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska awarded the City of Homer a
grant for \$75,000 to partially fund the design effort; and


WHEREAS, the City Council during 1982 appropriated \$50,000
of General Fund money for library land acquisition; and

WHEREAS, redesignation of the land acquisition funds of
\$50,000 to the design services project is desirable.



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council
that:

1. Library land acquisition funds of \$50,000 are
redesignated to partially fund the proposed library
expansion project.
2. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a library
expansion design contract with Architects Alaska in an
amount not to exceed \$79,184.
