RESOLUTION 88-66

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE FORMATION OF THE HIGHLAND DRIVE/UPLAND COURT ROAD RECONSTRUCTION IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PROCEED WITH THE PREPARATION AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held May 9, 1988 to hear objections or protests to the formation of such improvement district after property owners of the district were duly notified by certified mailing of such hearing and legal notice of hearing being advertised; and

WHEREAS, the objection deadline for written protest was July 7, 1988 and only (2) written protests were received equalling 6% of the total estimated property owner share of the project; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the improvement is desired by the property owners who equal more than 51% of the total cost of the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council that the Highland Drive/Upland Court Road Reconstruction Improvement District is hereby created and formed, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is instructed to proceed with the necessary preparations and construction of the improvement district and to prepare the assessment roll for presentation to the Homer City Council at a future date.
