RESOLUTION 88-76(A)

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL REQUESTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN ALLOWING HOTELS AND MOTELS AS A CONDITIONAL USE ON THE SPIT.

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council by Resolution 83-5 did approve the Homer Comprehensive Plan and recommended adoption by the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough by Ordinance 83-26 did adopt the Comprehensive Plan for the City of Homer as a portion of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Homer Municipal Code currently allows hotels and motels as a conditional use in the Marine Commercial Zoning District, while the Comprehensive Plan prohibits new hotels and motels on the Spit; and

WHEREAS, Council is anxious to resolve this discrepancy and feels it cannot afford to wait until the Comprehensive Plan is updated in that two separate companies are currently negotiating overslope development leases with the City and both companies indicate that they are interested in hotels on their respective boardwalks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council that:

Section I. The Homer Comprehensive Plan as adopted by Kenai Peninsula Borough Ordinance 83-26 be amended so that Policy 16 - Hotel, Motel and Residential be revised to read that overnight hotel and motel accommodations shall be allowed on the Spit as a conditional use.

Section II. This amendment is recommended to the Kenai Peninsula Borough for adoption as part of the current official Borough Comprehensive Plan within the Homer planning area.
