RESOLUTION 88-78

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL  
MODIFYING THE HIGHLAND DRIVE/UPLAND COURT  
ROAD RECONSTRUCTION IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT BY  
DELETING UPLAND COURT.

WHEREAS, Resolution 88-66 authorized the City Manager to proceed with the preparation and construction of the Highland Drive/Upland Court Road Reconstruction Improvement District; and

WHEREAS, during preliminary design of Upland Court it became apparent that due to severe topography the road does not have a favorable cost/benefit ratio; and

WHEREAS, reconstruction of Upland Court will require substantial easements on private property which the property owners are unwilling to provide to the City; and


WHEREAS, the owners of a majority of the value of the property to be benefitted are opposed to reconstruction as necessitated by the topography.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council that the Highland Drive/Upland Court Road Reconstruction Improvement District is hereby modified by deleting Upland Court due to its unfavorable cost/benefit ratio caused by severe topography.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the engineering cost for the preliminary engineering on Upland Court will be paid by the City of Homer in that the road design and slope easements cannot fit within the platted right-of-way.
