A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR HEATH STREET EXTENSION (FROM APPROXIMATELY GRUBSTAKE AVENUE TO PIONEER AVENUE TO THE FIRM OF HERNDON & HERNDON, INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$357,767.60 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Homer held a public bid opening on August 29, 1988 at 2:00 p.m. at Homer City Hall for the construction of approximately 1330 lineal feet of gravel road; 1325 lineal feet of D.I.P. water main line; 1130 storm sewer improvements; water and sewer service lines; reinforced concrete retaining wall; and all apprutenance so required as indicated on the project drawings and specifications; and

WHEREAS, the lowest bidder was the firm of Herndon & Herndon, Inc.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council that the contract for the Heath Street Extension be awarded to the firm of Herndon & Herndon, Inc., in the amount of \$357,767.60 and that the City Manager is authorized to sign the appropriate documents.
