RESOLUTION 88-85

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL  
CORRECTING THE EAST HILL ASSESSMENT ROLL,  
REVISING THE ASSESSMENT ON PARCEL #179-020-51  
FROM DIRECT TO INDIRECT, AND IDENTIFYING THE  
SEWER FUND AS FUNDING FOR THE DIFFERENCE IN  
THE ASSESSMENT AMOUNTS.

WHEREAS, an assessment roll for the East Hill Sewer  
Improvement District was confirmed on May 11, 1987, and

WHEREAS, it was later discovered that parcel # 179-020-51,  
belonging to B. M. and R. F. Owens and David and Bonnie Cooper,  
did not actually receive the stub-out and direct benefit for  
which it was assessed, due to a re-routing of the road after the  
assessment district was formed, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Common Council of the City  
of Homer that all assessment levies be equitable,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the  
City of Homer, that the assessment for parcel # 179-020-51 is  
hereby reduced from one direct and eight indirects (14,528.50) to  
nine indirects (\$9,900.00);

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the unassessed difference of  
\$4,628.50 shall be borne by the Sewer Fund, which owns the sewer  
asset; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this correction is hereby  
included as part of the East Hill Road Sewer LID confirmed  
assessment roll.
