RESOLUTION 88-96

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING CAPITAL PROJECTS/LEGISLATIVE REQUEST FOR FISCAL YEAR 1990 AND REQUESTING APPROPRIATE FUNDING.

WHEREAS, a duly published hearing was held on September 28 and October 10, 1988 in order to obtain public comments on recommended Fiscal Year 1989-94 capital improvement projects and legislative priorities; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council to provide the Governor and legislative delegation from District 5 adequate information to represent the desires of the City concerning legislative requests including necessary funding requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer, Alaska that the following Capital Improvement Projects are identified as the City of Homer priority list for Legislative Request in Fiscal Year 1990:

1. East End Road/Rochelle St. Intersection Reconst	\$ 150,000
2. KBBI Public Radio Station Completion	124,110
3. Replace State Harbor Floats - Phase I	500,000
4. Construct Fish Grinder	180,000
5. East End Road Design	500,000
6. Main Dock Repair	1,000,000
7. Kachemak Drive Design	250,000
8. Pratt Museum Renovation/Expansion-Phase I Completion	157,000
9. Homer Sr. Citizen Residential I & II Housing - Phase I	816,000
10. Develop Harbor Floats - Phase IIa	1,000,000

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby instructed to advise the Governor, Legislature and appropriate State agencies of the FY90 Capital Projects/Legislative Request adopted by the Homer City Council and to take all appropriate steps to provide the necessary background information.
