A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL ENDORSING THE EFFORTS OF THE SOUTH PENINSULA MENTAL HEALTH ASSOCIATION, INC., TO SECURE FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA MENTAL HEALTH TRUST FOR BUILDING EXPANSION.

WHEREAS, the City of Homer recognizes the value of the various services provided through the Community Mental Health Center including programs for the prevention of child abuse, respite care parent training, vocational counseling, community support for the chronically mentally ill, independent living rehabilitation and outpatient mental health services; and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer is aware of the gross lack of office space in the current facility owned by the Community Mental Health Center including an inadequate number of offices for clinical staff, administrative staff and waiting patients; and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer expressed support for a building program by allocating \$35,000 during November, 1982 to the Community Mental Health Center as seed money to successfully initiate land acquisition, building planning and a \$306,500 legislative appropriation from the State of Alaska.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Homer endorses the efforts of the South Peninsula Mental Health Association, Inc. (a private, non-profit organization), to secure appropriate funds from the State of Alaska Mental Health Trust in order to complete the proposed building expansion project.
