RESOLUTION 88-99

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING AREAWIDE PROJECTS AND REQUESTING THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH TO INCLUDE SUCH PROJECTS AS PART OF THEIR FY 1990 LEGISLATIVE REQUEST.

WHEREAS, a duly published hearing was held on September 26 and October 10, 1988 in order to obtain comments on recommended Fiscal Year 1990 Capital Improvement Projects and Legislative priorities; and

WHEREAS, a number of such projects have an areawide benefit and should therefore be considered as priorities by the Kenai Peninsula Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Homer, Alaska that the following capital improvement priorities are identified as projects of areawide benefit and are recommended to the Kenai Peninsula Borough for consideration as part of their legislative request for Fiscal Year 1990:

Community Mental Health Center Expansion	\$300,000
KBBI Public Radio Station Completion	124,110
Pratt Museum Renovation and Expansion Phase I Completion	157,000
Homer Sr. Citizen Building Expansion	450,000
Kachemak Drive Design	250,000
Homer Sr. Citizen Center Residential (Level I and II Housing Phase I)	816,000


