RESOLUTION 90-34

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL  
AMENDING THE PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY  
COMMISSION BY-LAWS TO ADDRESS JURISDICTION OF  
THE COMMISSION FOR EXTRA TERRITORIAL  
INTERESTS.

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Commission at their regular meeting of March 15, 1990 moved to advise the City Council that the Commission's jurisdiction is now limited to the city in the first paragraph of the Commission's bylaws and requested the City Council to extend their jurisdiction beyond the city limits to non contiguous interests; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney, Gordon Tans, reviewed this request and the language change to the Parks and Recreation Commission bylaws was submitted to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Commission at a special meeting held on April 5, 1990, moved to accept the bylaw change as submitted by the City Attorney; "... except for those extra territorial interests, such as trails and the city reservoir, subject to city jurisdiction."; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Commission at their regular meeting of April 19, 1990, moved to amend the proposed bylaw amendment by deleting "reservoir" and adding "properties", to read "...such as trails and city properties, subject to city jurisdiction."; and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Commission bylaws first paragraph, last sentence with the amendment now read; "The Commission's jurisdiction is limited to the area within the City boundaries except for those extra territorial interests, such as trails and city properties, subject to city jurisdiction."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Homer City Council that the Parks and Recreation Commission bylaws are hereby amended as recommended by the Parks and Recreation Commission.
