RESOLUTION 90-67

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL FINDING THE NEED TO CREATE THE MOUNTAIN VIEW DRIVE (ANDERSON 1976 AND ISLAND VIEW SUBDIVISIONS) PAVING LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AND SETTING A DATE FOR PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council has lifted the moratorium on the Homer Accelerated Roads Reconstruction Program for 1991 projects, and

WHEREAS, the petitioner met the deadline of October 1, 1990 with the request for improvement and the deadline of November 1, 1990 for return of signed petition; and

WHEREAS, the majority of the voters of the City of Homer approved for an increased sales tax rate for street reconstruction and related utilities in 1987; and

WHEREAS, Mountain View Drive (Anderson 1976 and Island View Subdivisions) fall with the guidelines of the Homer Accelerated Roads Program as a Group II, up to City Standards road; and


WHEREAS, a petition for paving of Mountain View Drive was submitted with greater than 51% of the value of property to be benefited property owner's signatures;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council that it is the intent of the City to form such an improvement district and that a public hearing will be held during the regular City Council meeting of Monday, November 12, 1990 at 7:30 p.m. for the purpose of hearing protests against the formation of said improvement district;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is authorized to compile the necessary information, establish boundaries and begin to prepare plans for the improvement in order to notify the property owners of such costs and the date of the hearing publicized as required by law.
