RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL NAMING  
UNNAMED RIGHT-OF-WAY WOODSIDE AVENUE

WHEREAS, Kenai Peninsula Borough Ordinance 85-35 establishes a uniform street naming system within the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, the said Borough ordinance allows for naming of streets within the Borough upon notification of adjoining property owners and holding of a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, said right-of-way is unnamed, paved and used by the public; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held before the Homer Advisory Planning Commission on November 14, 1990.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the right-of-way at Pioneer Avenue turning northwesterly into the Homer Middle School for 120 feet, then north for 170 feet, then west for 296 feet as dedicated on the Kenai Peninsula Borough Plat 74-2073 dated 10-16-74, is hereby officially named Woodside Avenue and so designated on the Kenai Peninsula Borough's official street name map.
