A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL
SUPPORTING FUNDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF LANDS
FROM SELDOVIA NATIVE ASSOCIATION WITHIN THE
BOUNDARIES OF THE KACHEMAK BAY STATE PARK.

WHEREAS, Kachemak Bay State Park is one of the most visited
state parks in southcentral Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the park is of vital interest to Homer, the Kenai
Peninsula Borough and the state of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the park boundaries incorporate lands selected by the
Seldovia Native Association; and

WHEREAS, the Homer City Council has previously supported
addition of land and a land exchange so that all areas within the
park could become park lands; and

WHEREAS, this purchase is contingent upon the legislature
appropriating necessary funding; and


WHEREAS, the acquisition of these lands, by purchase or
exchange, is important so that Seldovia Native Association may
proceed with plans to use these lands for the benefit of its
members and the State can properly plan for management of the park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council that
, the City Council supports House Bill 83 which appropriates funds
for the land and timber acquisition by the State of Alaska within
Kachemak Bay State Park.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk shall send copies
of this resolution to Governor Hickle, Senator Fischer and
Representatives Navarre and Phillips.
