A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL URGING GOVERNOR HICKEL, FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE STATE'S REAPPORTIONMENT PLAN, TO MAINTAIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH AS MUCH AS IS PRACTICAL AND POSSIBLE FOR THE HOUSE AND SENATE DISTRICTS.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough has been organized as a Borough since 1964 ;and

WHEREAS, the previous State apportionment plan withdrew areas from the Borough for both the House and Senate Districts; and

WHEREAS, the Reapportionment Committee's recommendation reunifies the Kenai Peninsula Borough for the House Districts, and as much as is possible, the Senate Districts; and


