RESOLUTION 91-57

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER, ALASKA, AWARDING THE BID FOR ONE SEWER CLEANING VACUUM TRUCK WITH AUTOMATIC TRANSMISSION FOR THE CLEANING OF SEWER MAINS, MANHOLES, PUMP STATIONS, AND STORM DRAIN CATCH BASINS, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$144,773.78 TO UTILITY EQUIPMENT OF SEATTLE AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works advertised for bids in the Homer News, Anchorage Daily News and the Seattle Journal of Commerce for one Sewer Cleaning Vacuum Truck; and


WHEREAS, the City also advertised an Additive Alternate in the bid for an automatic transmission for the vacuum truck. The Public Works Department feels that the automatic transmission will result in less downtime, fewer repairs and thus promote the life of the truck; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsive bidder is Utility Equipment of Seattle with a basic bid of \$140,273.78 and a bid of \$4,500 for the Additive Alternate of the automatic transmission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Homer, Alaska, that the bid for one Sewer Cleaning Vacuum Truck with automatic transmission is awarded to Utility Equipment of Seattle in an amount not to exceed \$144,773,78 and that the City Manager is authorized to sign the appropriate documents.
