A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES (DOT/PF) IN THEIR EFFORTS TO GAIN FUNDING FOR ROAD/UTILITY PROJECTS IN THE HOMER AREA

WHEREAS, efficient and reliable roads and utility systems is one of the most important responsibilities of state government; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Transportation is responsible for long range statewide planning of transportation projects as well as construction, operation and maintenance of all state transportation systems; and

WHEREAS, projects eligible for federal funding leverage limited state dollars and should therefore be considered as priority projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Homer, Alaska that the Council supports the following DOT/PF capital improvement priorities:

1. East End Road Design (to Homer City Limits) \$ 500,000

2. East End Road Reconstruction (to City Limits) \$ 3,000,000

3. Sterling Highway Reconstruction Design \$ 500,000

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby instructed to advise the Governor, Legislature and Department of Transportation and Public Facilities and the Kenai Peninsula Borough of the construction projects supported by the City for the Fiscal Year 1993 and to take all appropriate steps to provide the necessary background information.
