RESOLUTION 91-87(S)

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL NOTING
THE FAILURE OF THE MARINER DRIVE/STARBOARD WAY
WATER AND SEWER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, Mariner Drive runs north/south with Starboard Way a cul-de-sac on the west. Mariner Drive intersects East End Road on the North and dead ends on the south. This improvement district lies in the Mariner Village Subdivision and a portion in the Francis Thorn Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on October 7, 1991 to hear objections or protests to the formation of such improvement district after property owners of the district were duly notified by certified/return receipt mailing of such hearing and legal notice of hearing being advertised in the local weekly newspaper for four consecutive publications; and

WHEREAS, the objection deadline for written protests was December 6, 1991 and ten (10) written protests have been received equalling 78% objection; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the improvement is not desired by the property owners who bear more than fifty-one percent of the total project assessments to property to be benefitted pursuant to HCC 17.04.050.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Homer City Council that the Mariner Drive/Starboard Way Water and Sewer Improvement District has failed.
