A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL NOTING THE FAILURE OF KACHEMAK WAY ROAD RECONSTRUCTION AND PAVING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, Kachemak Way runs north/south, this LID stops at the intersection of Bayview Avenue on the south and dead ends on the north just past Mountain View Avenue. This street lies within the Anderson Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on October 7, 1991 to hear objections or protests to the formation of such improvement district after property owners of the district were duly notified by certified/return receipt mailing of such hearing and legal notice of hearing being advertised in the local weekly newspaper for four consecutive publications; and

WHEREAS, the objection deadline for written protests was December 6, 1991 and four (4) written protests have been received equalling 61.7% objection; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the improvement is not desired by the property owners who bear more than fifty-one percent of the total project assessments to property to be benefitted pursuant to HCC 17.04.050.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Homer City Council that the Kachemak Way Road Reconstruction and Paving Improvement District has failed.
