RESOLUTION 91-92

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE FORMATION OF THE CLOVER LANE/CLOVER PLACE ROAD RECONSTRUCTION AND PAVING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PROCEED WITH THE PREPARATION AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, Clover Lane runs north/south, intersecting East End Road on the north and Spruce Lane on the south. Clover Place is a cul-de-sac off of Clover Lane on the west. These streets lie within the Cooper Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on October 7, 1991 to hear objections or protests to the formation of such improvement district after property owners of the district were duly notified by certified/return receipt mailing of such hearing and legal notice of hearing being advertised in the local weekly newspaper for four consecutive publications; and

WHEREAS, the objection deadline for written protests was December 6, 1991 and five (5) written protests have been received equalling 28% objection; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the improvement is desired by the property owners who bear more than fifty-one percent of the total project assessments to property to be benefitted pursuant to HCC 17.04.050.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Homer City Council that the Clover Lane/Clover Place Road Reconstruction and Paving Improvement District is hereby created and formed; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is instructed to proceed with the necessary preparations and construction of the improvement district in the Summer of 1993 and finalize the assessment roll for presentation to the Homer City Council at a future date.
