A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL
AWARDING THE PROFESSIONAL
ARCHITECTURAL/ENGINEERING SERVICES CONTRACT TO
DESIGN THE CITY OF HOMER AIRPORT TERMINAL IN
THE AMOUNT OF \$114,000 TO CASH BARNER USHER
ARCHITECTS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO
SIGN THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, on October 3, 10, and 17 advertisement for a Request for Proposals for the Professional Architectural/Engineering Services for the Design of an Airport Terminal for the City of Homer was published in the Homer News, Peninsula Clarion and the Alaska Journal of Commerce; and

WHEREAS, on October 25, 1991 the City of Homer received nine proposals from firms interest in providing professional services to design the City of Homer Airport Terminal; and

WHEREAS, the selection criteria committee consisting of the City Engineer, City Grants Coordinator, Chairman of the Airport Advisory Committee and a representative of the ADOT reviewed and rated the proposals in accordance with the FAA standards; and

WHEREAS, FAA reviewed the selection and contract and have given approval regarding both; and

WHEREAS, Cash Barner Usher Architects is the firm with the best proposal to perform the required services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Homer City Council that the Homer Airport Terminal RFP for Professional Architectural/Engineering Services be awarded to the firm of Cash Barner Usher Architects in the amount of \$114,000 and that the City Manager is authorized to sign the appropriate documents.
