A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL REQUESTING FUNDING FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION AND SUPPORTING THEIR EFFORTS TO GAIN FUNDING FOR D.E.C. PROJECTS IN THE HOMER AREA.

WHEREAS, efficient and reliable water & sewer systems is one of the most important responsibilities of state government; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation is responsible for long range statewide planning of such projects;

WHEREAS, projects eligible for federal funding leverage limited state dollars and should therefore be considered as priority projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Homer, Alaska that the Council supports the following D.E.C. improvement priorities:
