A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER, ALASKA AUTHORIZING THE FORMATION OF THE KACHEMAK WAY ROAD RECONSTRUCTION AND PAVING IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PROCEED WITH THE PREPARATION AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, Kachemak way a road which runs north and south from Mountain View Drive on the north to Pioneer Avenue on the south. the Project area lies from Mountain View Drive to the north corners of Bayview Avenue and Kachemak Way intersection. Kachemak Way lies within the Anderson subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing was held on September 28, 1992 a Regular Council meeting to hear objections or protests to the formation of such improvement district after property owners of the district were duly notified by certified/return receipt mailing of such hearing and legal notice of hearing being advertised in the Homer News for four consecutive publications; and

WHEREAS, the objection deadline for written protests was November 27, 1992 and three written protests have been received equalling 39% objection; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council that the City Manager is authorized to proceed with the preparation and construction of the Kachemak Way road reconstruction and paving improvement district.
