RESOLUTION 92-13(S)

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER, ALASKA DISSOLVING THE HIGHLAND DRIVE PHASE II ROAD RECONSTRUCTION IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, Highland Drive Phase II, a road which runs east/west with cul-de-sacs on the north and south, connecting with Highland Drive Phase I HARP Project which intersects West Hill Road on the east and dead ends on the west. Highland Drive Phase II lies within the Mountain Park Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing was held on October 7, 1991 at a Special Council meeting to hear objections or protests to the formation of such improvement district after property owners of the district were duly notified by certified/return receipt mailing of such hearing and legal notice of hearing being advertised in the Homer News for four consecutive publications; and


WHEREAS, the objection deadline for written protests was December 6, 1991 and ten written protests have been received equalling 43% objection; and

WHEREAS, after review by the Road Standards Committee and the City Manager, with confirmation by the City Attorney, it has been determined that due to the complexities of the Highland Drive Phase II LID that this improvement district should be dissolved at this time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Homer City Council that the Highland Drive Phase II road reconstruction improvement district is hereby dissolved.
