A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL
AWARDING WOOD GRID REPAIR CONTRACT TO TANGO
CONSTRUCTION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
\$28,350 AND AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY
MANAGER TO SIGN THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, on March 5, 1992 at 2:00 p.m. sealed bids were received and opened for the Port of Homer, Catwalk Repair project as advertised in the Homer News on February 20 and 27, 1992; and

WHEREAS, there were two bids submitted for the project by Tango Construction and Jay/Brant General Contractors exceeded the funds available and were over 50% higher than the engineer's estimate; and


WHEREAS, the Public Works Department reduced the scope of work to be done and asked the two bidders to resubmit proposals due April 3, 1992 by 5:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, Tango Construction submitted the lower of the two bids in the amount of \$28,350.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Homer City Council, of Homer, Alaska, that the Wood Grid Repair Contract be awarded to Tango Construction in an amount not to exceed \$28,350 and authorizing the Interim City Manager to sign the appropriate documents.
