AWARDING THE CITY HALL RETAINING WALL
PROJECT TO THE FIRM OF HERNDON & THOMPSON
INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$12,400
AND AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM CITY MANAGER
TO SIGN THE APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, on May 14, 1992 at 2:00 p.m. sealed bids were received and opened for the City Hall Retaining Wall Project as advertised in the Homer News and Peninsula Clarion on April 16, 23 and 30, 1992; and

WHEREAS, there were three (3) bids submitted for the project and HERNDON & THOMPSON INC. submitted the lowest responsive bid in the amount of \$12,400.


