RESOLUTION 92-79

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL, CITY OF HOMER, ALASKA APPROVING THE HOMER FERRY TERMINAL AGREEMENT AND LAND USE PERMIT WITH THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the City has been working with Alaska DOT/PF regarding the Homer Ferry Terminal; and

WHEREAS, this project will benefit both the City of Homer and the Alaska DOT/PF.

WHEREAS, final negotiations and plan review has been completed with the ADOT/PF, ROW Division, and it is currently anticipated that the first phase of the project will be warded by the end of November and that the new Port/Harbor Shop building will be in place by the end of May 1992; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for both parties to give final approval to the attached Homer Ferry Terminal Agreement and Land use Permit, which has been reviewed by the City Attorney, staff and representatives of ADOT/PF.


