RESOLUTION 92-85

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL
AWARDING THE 30 ACRE WATER AND SEWER
UTILITIES ENGINEERING DESIGN TO THE FIRM
OF WILLIAM NELSON, P.E. OF KENAI IN AN
AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$15,380 AND
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE
APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, in 1988 William Nelson, P.E. of Kenai designed a water system to the new dock, which was not constructed due to funding limitations; and

WHEREAS, in 1989 R.W. Beck prepared a design for a sewer system for the 30 acres, this subsystem was not included in the Spit Sewer project; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to expedite the completion of the 1993 30 acre utilities project Public Works contacted Mr. Nelson and requested a fee proposal to adjust the utility lines to reflect the new Spit plat and to combine the two designs into one construction package; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Nelson responded with a fee proposal of \$15,380 which is reasonable and reflects the most effective and timely way to achieve the desired result. Surveying will be completed before winter, the design finalized before breakup, and construction completed prior to Memorial Day 1993.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Homer City Council, of Homer, Alaska, that the 30 Acres Water and Sewer Utilities Project design be awarded to the firm of William Nelson, P.E., located in Kenai, Alaska, in an amount not to exceed \$15,380 and that the City Manager is authorized to sign the appropriate documents.
