RESOLUTION 92-91

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL
AWARDING THE EAST END ROAD WATER TIE-IN,
PROFESSIONAL SURVEYING/DRAFTING SERVICES
TO THE FIRM OF HERNDON & THOMPSON IN AN
AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$5,280 AND
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE
APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, on September 23, 1992 the City solicited proposals
from four Homer land surveyors and engineers for the East End Road
Water Tie-In, Professional Surveying and Drafting services; and

WHEREAS, on October 8, 1992 the City received proposals from
two land surveyors; Herndon & Thompson and Ability Surveys; and


WHEREAS, the work involved with this RFP (Request for
Proposals) is of a routine, non specialized nature, fees were
requested and considered in the analysis; and

WHEREAS, Herndon & Thompson received the highest amount of
points and had the lowest fee proposal in the amount of \$5,280.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Homer City Council, of
Homer, Alaska, that the East End Water Tie-In, Professional
Surveying/Drafting Services be awarded to the firm of Herndon &
Thompson in an amount not to exceed \$5,280 and authorizes the City
Manager to sign the appropriate documents.
