RESOLUTION 92-93

A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL
REQUESTING GOVERNOR HICKEL TO RECONSIDER THE
REAPPORTIONMENT PRECINCT BOUNDARY LINES WITHIN
THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HOMER.

WHEREAS, the reapportionment boundary change does nothing to benefit the Homer precincts but creates confusion; and

WHEREAS, the precinct lines in Homer were equal and reasonable prior to the Hickel reapportionment; and

WHEREAS, this reapportionment has increased misunderstanding and confusion regarding Homer I, II and III precinct boundary lines; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Homer that Governor Hickel is requested to restore the precinct boundary lines of Homer I, II and III to the following:

Homer Precinct No. 1, West Homer; the portion of the City of Homer which lies WEST OF MAIN STREET.

Homer Precinct No. 2,; Northeast Homer, beginning at the intersection of the extended centerline of Main Street, on the northern boundary of the City of Homer, then in an easterly direction along the City of Homer boundary to the section line common to Sections 14 and 23, R13W, T6S, SM; then westerly along the section line to the intersection of the centerline of Main Street; then northerly along the centerline of Main Street and its extension to the point of beginning.

Homer Precinct No. 3, Southeast Homer); Beginning at the southwest corner of Section 17, R13W, T6W, SM; then easterly along the section line to the boundary of the City of Homer; then in a southerly direction along the City of Homer boundary to the intersection of the extended centerline of Main Street; then northerly along the centerline of Main Street, and its extension to the point of beginning.
