A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING  
CAPITAL PROJECTS/LEGISLATIVE REQUEST FOR FISCAL  
YEAR 1996 AND REQUESTING APPROPRIATE FUNDING.

WHEREAS, a duly published hearing was held on October 24, 1994 in order to obtain public comments on recommended Fiscal Year 1996 capital improvement projects and legislative priorities; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council to provide the Governor and Legislative delegation from District 7 adequate information to represent the desires of the City concerning legislative requests including necessary funding requirements.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Homer, Alaska that the following Capital Improvement Projects are identified as the City of Homer priority list for Legislative Request in Fiscal Year 1996:
