A RESOLUTION OF THE HOMER CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES (DOT/PF) IN THEIR EFFORTS TO GAIN FUNDING FOR PORT/HARBOR PROJECTS IN THE HOMER AREA.

WHEREAS, an efficient and reliable port and harbor system is one of the most important responsibilities of state government; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Transportation is responsible for long range statewide planning of port and harbor projects as well as construction, operation and maintenance of all state transportation systems; and

WHEREAS, projects are eligible for federal funding leverage limited state dollars and should therefore be considered as priority projects;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Homer, Alaska that the Council supports the following DOT/PF capital improvement priorities:
