RESOLUTION 94-125

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER, ALASKA, AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR A LAND AND WATER CONSERVATION FUND GRANT FOR THE PURPOSES OF UPGRADING FACILITIES AT BISHOP'S BEACH PARK.

WHEREAS, this resolution would authorize application for funding assistance for an outdoor recreation project to the State Liaison Officer as provided by the Land and Water Conservation Fund; and,

WHEREAS, under provision of the Land and Water Conservation Fund, federal funding assistance has been authorized and made available to aid in financing partial costs of land for parks and partial costs for the construction of outdoor recreational facilities for local public bodies; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Homer has approved the Homer Comprehensive plan which identifies Bishop's Beach as an official park; and,

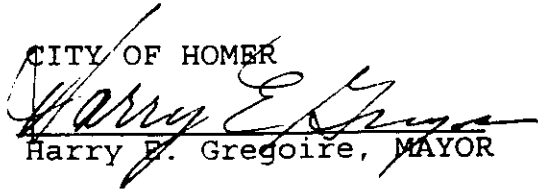
WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Homer considers in the best public interest to upgrade the facilities at Bishop's Beach Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Homer City Council that:

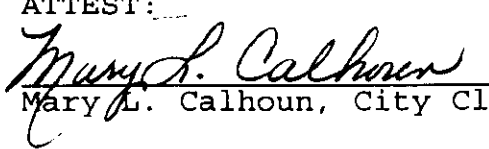
1. That the City Manager is authorized to make formal application to the State Liaison Officer for funding assistance; and,
2. That any funding assistance received be used in the development of Bishop's Beach park; and,
3. That any property developed with financial aid through the State Liaison Officer be placed in use as an outdoor recreation area and be retained in such use in perpetuity, and,
4. That is resolution become part of a formal application to the Alaska Division of Parks and Outdoor Recreation.
