RESOLUTION 96-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMER TO PROVIDE FOR BILLING FOR RESCUE SERVICES BY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO HCC 1.60.070(a)(2).

WHEREAS, the Fire Department provides rescue services to approximately 8,500 residents of the Homer area; and

WHEREAS, as revenues continue to decline, significant service cuts will occur if additional revenues are not developed; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City to continue to provide quality rescue services to those in the Homer area who require these services; and

WHEREAS, no fees are presently charged by the Fire Department for rescue services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Homer to provide for billing for rescue services by the Homer Fire Department pursuant to HCC 1.60.070(a)(2) as follows, to be included in the City's fee schedule:

Rescue Services	\$250.00
Mileage	5.00/mile
Supplies	Actual Replacement cost

This fee schedule shall be implemented on April 1, 1996.
