RESOLUTION 99-15(A)

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA FINDING A NEED TO CREATE THE HAZEL AVENUE ROAD RECONSTRUCTION AND PAVING IMPROVEMENT/ASSESSMENT DISTRICT AND SETTING A DATE FOR PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, the City of Homer finds the need to create a local improvement/assessment district pursuant to HCC 17.04.030 (b) for reconstruction and paving of Hazel Avenue; and

WHEREAS, development of this road is needed to alleviate congestion due to the recent construction of several businesses and would improve traffic safety; and

WHEREAS, First National Bank of Alaska has improved a small portion of Hazel Avenue and National Bank of Alaska has improved an additional 206 lineal feet; and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer owns all the property on the north of Hazel Avenue and USFW owns one large parcel to the south; and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer/HARP would be bearing the expense for the largest portion of this improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Homer will include traffic calming and on street parking in the design.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Homer finds the need to create the Hazel Avenue Road Reconstruction and Paving Improvement/Assessment District and sets a date for public hearing of March 22, 1999 at a Regular Council Meeting; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a parking design be approved by the City Council.
