A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF HOMER, ALASKA REQUESTING THE LEGISLATURE TO FULLY FUND THE ALASKA COOPERATIVE EXTENSION AND THE UNIVERSITY OF ALASKA.

WHEREAS, the members of the Alaska Association of Municipal Clerks are dedicated to their professional growth through advanced education and development and it is through the Alaska Cooperative Extension (ACE) and the University of Alaska that this training and certification is possible; and

WHEREAS, ACE has directly helped tens of thousands of Alaskans who annually attend workshops and receive information critical to their family, homes, businesses, and communities; and

WHEREAS, ACE is part of the College of Rural Alaska, with extended campuses across Alaska, and through UAF, part of the University of Alaska system; and

WHEREAS, President Mark Hamilton and the UA Board of Regents have proposed a realistic budget for the University of Alaska system; and


