

The total amount spent for legal services by the City of Homer is disclosed in General Fund account 5210 (professional services) in the Mayor/Council in the annual budget.

- 2) Are there ongoing needs such as a hearing officer which might be met without taking on the entire legal service requirements of the city? The City employees the State of Alaska Office of Administrative Hearings for Hearing Officer needs. These are funded through General Fund account 5210 (professional services) in the Mayor/Council budget. As a matter of policy, the City employs legal counsel who do not work for the City in any other capacity in order to maintain transparency and public trust in the decisions of the Hearing Officer.
- 3) Are there other carve outs similarly situated which might be served by the local Homer bar? The reference to carve outs is unclear.
- 4) Has the city considered bringing an attorney in house, for part or some of its requirements? No. Information was provided to Council on the cost of a full time attorney in 2016 as part of the back-up for renewing the contract with the attorney.
- 5) Many cities publish an annual report on their use of and compensation for legal services. Does the city likewise publish such a report? No. A written attorneys' report is provided to Council throughout the year summarizing legal services provided and ongoing issues.
